2. **Preamble of the Syllabus:** Post Graduate Certificate Programme in Cyber Law and Diploma/ Certificate Course in Corporate Law are programmes of Kumaun University of Uttarakhand. The Choice Based Credit System to be implemented through curriculum, would allow students to develop a strong footing in the fundamentals and specialize in the discipline of his/her liking and abilities. The students pursuing these programmes would have to develop in depth understanding of various aspects of the subject.

3. **Programme Objectives**

- 1) To impart knowledge in the specific areas of law, to gain advanced insight into the subjects.
- 2) To analyze and evaluate the current legal issues and propose solutions.
- 3) To apply professional knowledge in practicality.
- 4) To inculcate Research ethics and thereby contribute to the holistic development of the students.
- 5) Students should have general understanding of the trends in regulation of capital markets and foreign investments.

4. **Programme Outcomes**

- 1) To demonstrate an understanding to the basic concepts, principles, doctrine, and theories in their respective specialized PG Diploma.
- 2) Knowledge of Cyber World and Cyber Law in general
- 3) Understanding various aspects of cyber-crimes.
- 4) Understanding the problems relating to e-commerce transactions
- 5) Intellectual Property issues in IT Act

  
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- 6) Development of an insight to the international perspective in Cyber Law
- 7) Enhancement of their presentation and research abilities.

**5. Programme Specific Outcomes:**

- 1) To enable an understanding of the basic concepts and contemporary legal developments in Cyber Law and Corporate Laws.
- 2) To enhance advocacy and legal research skills.
- 3) To assess and contribute to policy making/advocacy through fresh perspectives that arises out of the comparative study of the systems.
- 4) To develop a sharper academic acumen and will be able to contribute to academic research and publications.


**6. Course Description**

Post Graduate Certificate Programme in Cyber Law is oneyear Programme fundamentally involving issues related to the internet, communication technology, technological and electronic elements including hardware, software, computer and information systems, and their resolution.

Post Graduate Certificate Programme in Corporate Law is one year Certificate Programme that equips candidates with in-depth knowledge about various business and corporate legislation along with details of how to integrate law into strategic business policies, solve complex business problems and protect and leverage the company's resources. It involves a detailed study of all matters within the corporate sector, from the birth of companies to their dissolution and issues related to the floatation of companies, corporate governance, among others.

**7. The purpose and object of the course:**

- 1) To introduce the cyber world and cyber law in general.
- 2) To explain about the various dimensions/aspects of cyber-crimes.
- 3) To enhance the understanding of problems arising out of online transactions and enable them to find solutions.

  
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- 4) To clarify the Intellectual Property issues in the cyber space and the growth and development of the law in this regard.
- 5) To educate about the regulation of cyber space at national and international level.

#### **8. Eligibility**

Graduate in any discipline from a recognized University with 45% marks for General and 40% Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes. Students who have appeared for final year of examination of their bachelor's degree or are awaiting results can also apply, subject to successfully completing their Bachelor's Degree Program at the date of counseling for admission as specified by the University.

#### **9. Mode of Admission**

Based on academic merit. Merit will be calculated according to the norms set by Kumaun University, Nainital.

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#### **10. Duration of Course**

On passing in both the semesters the candidates will be given Post Graduate Certificate in Cyber Laws (PGCCYL) / Post Graduate Certificate in Corporate Laws (PGCCOL).

#### **11. Seats**


As permitted by the University.

#### **12. Course Fees:**

For the Post Graduate Certificate in Cyber Law/ Corporate Law the total fee shall be Rs. 30,000/- to be charged semester wise (i.e., 15000/- per Semester).

#### **13. Employment Opportunities**

The Cyber Law and Corporate Law experts are in great demand in public and private organization, Law and IT firms, Police Department, Banks, Insurance Sector,

  
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Corporate Sector, Universities etc. and this will continue to rise further in this age of digitization.

The various positions of employment are: Cyber Lawyer, Cyber Law Advisor, Cyber Assistant, Cyber Consultant, Research Assistant and Security Auditors, Corporate Lawyer, Legal managers, Law officers, Audit manager, Contract and Commercial manager, corporate events Associate etc.

#### **14. Medium of Instruction**

The medium of instruction and examination will be English/ Hindi.

#### **15. Examination and evaluation**

There shall be internal as well as semester end examination. The examination shall comprise of 100 marks in each Course/Paper out of which 75 marks are for theory and 25 marks are for internal assessment. The examination schedule containing the date of receipt of examination forms with and without late fee shall be notified by the Controller of Examinations from time to time.


The candidate is to clear all the examinations within two consecutive years from the date of admission in the aforementioned Certificate Programme.

While marks are given for all internal and end semester examinations for a maximum number of 100 each, they will be converted into grades by the University. Semester end grade sheets will have only grades & final grade sheets and transcripts shall have grade points average and total percentage of marks.

The candidate shall have to secure at least 45% marks separately in each course/paper in theory as well as internal assessment to pass the examination.
